DAY 1 – THE POWER OF THE NAME OF JESUS TO HEAL

The ministry of divine healing is important in anyone's life who is a believer. Jesus commanded us to "go in His Name." Let's focus on the absolute importance of divine healing and divine health. Jesus was a Prophet and a Rabbi.

- I. The ministry of divine healing is important in anyone's life who is a believer.
 - Jesus told His disciples to go into all the world and preach the gospel. Those who believe will be saved. Those who don't, won't (Mark 16:15-16).
 - Jesus is the same yesterday, today and forever. Jesus will be good and wonderful tomorrow just like He is today (Hebrews 13:8).
- II. Jesus commanded His disciples, and us, to "go in His Name."
 - These were the last few words of Jesus in the earth. He was giving final orders to those who believe in Him (Mark 16:15-18).
 - o "These signs shall follow them who believe. In My Name..."
 - Jesus delegated the power of attorney to the believer.
 - o He said, "In My Name, they shall cast out devils."
 - That means *you* must do something about the devil. *You* have the Name and the authority.
 - o They shall speak with new tongues. That means you.
 - Learn to yield your tongue to the Spirit of God.
 - Go ahead and speak in tongues by faith to please The LORD.
 - The word of The LORD through Brother Copeland: "You'll not be like a little puppy that knows not how to pray. You'll not be helpless and unable to contact Me," saith The LORD. "All you have to do is yield to the Holy Spirit, let Me have your tongue, and I will rise up on the inside of you, and I will give you the utterance. I will hear it and I will answer it, and it will come to pass."
 - The believers are to take up serpents; that means defeating the devil and unclean demons, not actually handling snakes.
 - o The believer will not be hurt by drinking any deadly thing.





- They shall lay hands on the sick and they shall recover.
- The Father within us does the works (John 14:10).
- III. Focus on the absolute importance of divine healing and divine health.
 - Jesus set the Church against sickness and disease. Choose to follow Jesus.
 - o The new birth is important because it deals with a person's eternity.
 - "That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth The LORD Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved" (Romans 10:9).
 - The definition of saved—the Greek word sozo: "To save, keep safe and sound; to rescue from danger or destruction, injury or peril; to save a suffering one (from perishing), i.e., one suffering from disease; to make well, heal, restore to health; to preserve one who is in danger of destruction; to save or rescue; to save from evil."
 - That's what you received when you accepted Jesus as your LORD and Savior.
 - Jesus is your Rescuer from the peril of death and hell, sickness, disease and poverty; and gave you eternal residence together forever with Him.
 - Jesus gave His followers the power to cast out demons and heal all manner of sickness and disease (Matthew 10:1, AMPC).
 - These men were disciples until that moment. Then they became apostles of Jesus Christ: sent ones.
- IV. Jesus was a Prophet and a Rabbi.
 - At age 30, Jesus was baptized in the Jordan River and entered into His ministry.
 - Then He was sent into the wilderness to undo what Adam had done.
 - Jesus passed the food test (eat of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil) and two other temptations.
 - o The devil left for a better time, but it never came.
 - If they had known, they would not have crucified The LORD of glory (1 Corinthians 2:8).

MAKE IT PERSONAL

The Name of Jesus is the most powerful Name you can call on. Seek Him as your Source.

Make this declaration:

"The power of the Name of Jesus is mine today. I'm in awe of the magnitude of power in Jesus' Name. I choose not to forget the Love and power of God that's been given to me. I will depend on Jesus as my Source and share God's Love at every opportunity. In Jesus' Name. Amen."

DAY 2 - SENT AND AUTHORIZED BY JESUS TO MINISTER HEALING

In order to be obedient to the Commander in Chief and His ministry—Jesus, who is known as the Healer—we have to preach. Jesus, a Holy Thing, was conceived in Mary's womb by the Holy Spirit. He was born of the Holy Spirit. Jesus appointed 70 more besides the 12 disciples to go out and preach, deliver and heal. The LORD's prayer states, "Your kingdom come, Your will be done."

- I. In order to be obedient to the Commander in Chief and His ministry—Jesus, who is known as the Healer—we have to preach.
 - Jesus went into the synagogue and read, "The Spirit of The LORD is upon Me and has anointed Me to preach" (Luke 4:18).
 - Jesus had to preach so the hearers would have faith to be healed.
 - o "Faith comes by hearing and hearing by The WORD of God" (Romans 10:17).
- II. Jesus, a Holy Thing, was conceived in Mary's womb by the Holy Spirit. He was born of the Holy Spirit.
 - When you were born again, the Holy Spirit hovered over you and a holy thing was born in you.
 - o Your spirit was born again, and you were re-created in God's image.
 - Jesus was baptized in the Jordan when He was 30 years old.
 - The Holy Spirit within Jesus became the Holy Spirit upon Him (Luke 3:21-22).
 - John said, "The Messiah shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost and fire" (Luke 3:16).
 - It was time for Jesus to enter His ministry on the earth: to be God manifested in the flesh.
 - John's last name was not *Baptist*. Jesus' last name is not *Christ*.
 - John was known by what he preached—water baptism.
 - Baptism will not save you, but being baptized in water is an act of your obedience.





- When you are baptized in and with the Holy Spirit, you step into another dimension of power.
- III. Jesus appointed 70 more besides the 12 disciples to go out and preach, deliver and heal. They were doing what Jesus did.
 - Jesus said the harvest is great but the laborers are few. Pray to The LORD to send more (Luke 10:1-2).
 - They were not to take supplies with them (Luke 10:4).
 - Jesus wasn't instructing them to be poor; He wanted them to focus on the mission. Jesus called, ordained and supplied what they needed.
 - These men were wealthy; we know this because they were tithers (Malachi 3:10-11).
 - They were given authority.
 - o Jesus told them, "When you enter a house, say, 'Peace be upon you.' Heal the sick and say, 'The kingdom of God has come nigh you.' He that hears you, hears Me. He that despises you, despises Me" (Luke 10:5, 9-11, 16)
 - Jesus told them not to rejoice that spirits were subject to them, but to rejoice that their names were written in heaven (Luke 10:20).
 - Jesus rejoiced in spirit and thanked God for revealing to babies that He was the Son of God (Luke 10:21-22).
- IV. The LORD's Prayer states, "Your kingdom come, Your will be done" (Matthew 6:10).
 - The kingdom of God came when Jesus ministered on the earth.
 - $\bullet \quad \text{We have been given authority in the kingdom of God.}$
 - Jesus said, "I give unto you power or authority to tread on serpents and scorpions and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you" (Luke 10:19).

MAKE IT PERSONAL

You are sent and authorized to pray with people who need healing. Stay in love and be courageous. You are the one to show them the Love of Jesus. They need your prayers.

DAY 3 – REPRESENT THE HEALER WHEREVER YOU ARE

You are in the ministry of Jesus. Jesus was called a Nazarene because He was from Nazareth. He obeyed God's plan by being baptized in water. The Spirit of the living God, who planned your life before the foundation of the world, knows your future.

- I. You are in the ministry of Jesus.
 - We follow Jesus the Christ—Jesus of Nazareth. As we follow Him, we are His
 disciples.
 - There is a difference between being disciplined and being a disciple.
 - o A disciple receives discipline (correction) from the teacher.
 - In our case, we, as followers (disciples) of Jesus, receive discipline from Him through the Holy Spirit.
- II. Jesus was called a Nazarene because He was from Nazareth (Matthew 2:23).
 - A Nazarite is one who takes a specific vow to The LORD: for example, Samson (Judges 13:3-5).
 - Jesus was conceived in Mary's womb and born of the Spirit (Luke 1:34-35).
 - Joseph was Jesus' stepdad. His brothers and sisters probably resented Jesus because He was perfect.
 - We were reborn of the Spirit of God and now we are like Jesus.
- III. Jesus obeyed God's plan by being baptized in water (Luke 3:21).
 - Immediately Jesus went out into the desert place and fasted (Luke 4:1-2).
 - Jesus returned in the Spirit to the Galilee...being glorified of all (Luke 4:14-16).
 - o He came to Nazareth where He had been brought up.
 - Jesus said, "The Spirit of The LORD is upon Me because..." (Luke 4:18).
 - What follows are the specific Anointings of Jesus.
 - o Preach the good news and heal. This is the responsibility of every ministry.
 - o Preach the acceptable year of The LORD. That's a Jubilee year.
 - 2022 is a *Shemitah* year. It is a year of release, if you believe it by faith.





- IV. The Spirit of the living God, who planned your life before the foundation of the world, knows your future.
 - God is against sickness and poverty in any form (Luke 4:18-19).
 - o Poor man, you don't have to be poor anymore.
 - o Sick man, you don't have to be sick or blind; Jesus is here.
 - He preached the acceptable year of The LORD to the poor, so they didn't have to be poor or brokenhearted any more.
 - o Bruised people, there's liberty, salvation and deliverance for you.
 - Jesus began to say, "This day is this scripture fulfilled in your ears" (Luke 4:21).
 - o He preached THE BLESSING, and that made the religious people mad.
 - You should be healed, born again and baptized in the Holy Spirit today.
 - Today is the day of salvation. Faith is NOW!

MAKE IT PERSONAL

Don't be afraid to share your belief that God wants to save, heal and deliver everyone you meet. Ask if you can pray for them. Almost every time, they will respond favorably.

DAY 4 – THE POWER OF FAITH AND LOVE TO HEAL

It's an absolute necessity to know about the power of faith and love to heal. We ask and receive; we knock and it's opened to us; we seek (research) and find. What is faith and how does it work? Christ fulfilled the law of righteousness for everyone who believes. The Word of Faith is a way of life.

- I. It's an absolute necessity to know about the power of faith and love to heal.
 - The truth that God is Love (1 John 4:8) was written by the apostle of Love, the Apostle John.
 - Sickness is defeated by faith, and faith works by love (Galatians 5:6).
 - He also wrote that perfected love casts out fear because fear has torment (1 John 4:18).
- II. We ask and receive; we knock and it's opened to us; we seek (research) and find.
 - Search out the scriptures that cover your situation and pray those words back to God in faith.
 - o Be confident and thank God because it's done. You have it now.
 - The devil cannot touch you (1 John 5:18).
 - Jesus gave us a commandment to love one another in the same way He loves us (John 13:34).
 - We also have the commandment to love our neighbor as ourselves because love does no evil to his neighbor (Romans 13:9-10).
- III. What is faith and how does it work?
 - "Now faith is the assurance (the confirmation, the title deed) of the things [we] hope for, being the proof of things [we] do not see and the conviction of their reality [faith perceiving as real fact what is not revealed to the senses]" (Hebrews 11:1, AMPC).
 - Faith is a strong, unseen force that can be measured, strengthened and built up.
 - o Faith always comes by hearing the Anointed WORD of God (Romans 10:17).





- Faith perceives God's WORD as reality.
- When is faith? Now! The power of faith you have in your spirit being is the faith of God.
 - Now faith is the assurance and confirmation that God will keep His WORD—including His WORD about healing.
- IV. Christ fulfilled the law of righteousness for everyone who believes (Romans 10:4).
 - Jesus died the death of a sinner to take our place. He went to hell so we don't have to go. He was raised up from the dead so we could be raised up from the dead in that final day.
 - Everything Jesus bought and paid for on the cross belongs to us.
 - He bore our sins, so we resist sin.
 - He bore our sicknesses, diseases and pains, so by faith we have the right to resist sickness, disease and pain.
 - o He was resurrected; we get resurrected from death.
 - o Everything He bought is ours. He was our substitute.
 - Jesus set all whom He ordained into His ministry against sickness and disease.
 - He said, "You go heal the sick, raise the dead and cast out devils."
 - The Greek word for *salvation* Paul used is *sozo* which means "saved and healed" (Romans 10:8-15).
- V. The Word of Faith is a way of life. The faith of God is inside you.
 - Receiving Jesus as Savior and LORD is really simple. Jesus made it simple.
 - Jesus did all the hard part: He suffered on the cross, was separated from His Father and was tormented in the belly of the earth.
 - Jesus is the Source of salvation, and His WORD is the power.

DAY 5 – WHAT IS THE LAYING ON OF HANDS?

The book of Hebrews is the gospel to the Jews. The mission statement of Kenneth Copeland Ministries is found in the book of Hebrews. God said His Name is *Jehovah Rapha*, the God who heals you. The foundational principal doctrines of Christ are written in Hebrews.

- I. The book of Hebrews is the gospel to the Jews.
 - Paul was uniquely qualified to teach to the Jews. He was educated and lived as a Pharisee until he had an encounter with Jesus.
 - God changed Saul's name to Paul to indicate that Paul was in covenant with God.
- II. The mission statement of Kenneth Copeland Ministries is found in the book of Hebrews.
 - "For when for the time ye ought to be teachers, ye have need that one teach you again which be the first principles of the oracles of God; and are become such as have need of milk, and not of strong meat. For every one that useth milk is unskilful in the word of righteousness: for he is a babe. But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, even those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil" (Hebrews 5:12-14).
 - We need to teach spiritual babies and help them become mature believers.
 - Find a church that teaches the Word of Faith.
- III. God said His Name is *Jehovah Rapha*, the God who heals you (Exodus 15:26).
 - If divine healing stopped, God would have to change His Name.
 - There is no changing in God. He doesn't need to change; He's right the first time.
 - It needs to be taught and believed that God is the Healer, forever!
 - The devil is the one who brought sickness and disease.
 - Any kind of sickness and disease is a result of satanic oppression.
 - Jesus went about healing all who were oppressed by the devil (Acts 10:38).
 - Preach it! Teach it! Expect it!





- IV. The foundational principal doctrines of Christ are written in Hebrews.
 - "Therefore, leaving the principles of the doctrine [or teaching] of Christ, let us go on unto perfection; not laying again the foundation [or fundamental teachings of Christ] of repentance from dead works, and of faith toward God, of the doctrine of baptisms, and of laying on of hands, and of resurrection of the dead, and of eternal judgment" (Hebrews 6:1-2).
 - There are several baptisms: baptisms in water, baptized into the Body of Christ, baptized in the Holy Spirit.
 - Laying on of hands is of God. Jesus, Peter and Paul laid hands on the sick and the sick recovered.
 - Jesus laid hands on Peter's mother-in-law because she had a fever. She was immediately healed, got up and cooked a meal for them (Luke 4:38-39).
 - "The Spirit of The LORD is upon Me, for He has anointed Me to preach" (Luke 4:18).
 - o Jesus had the Spirit *upon* Him, and we can also have the Holy Spirit upon us.
