DAY 1 – THE POWER TO HEAL IS IN YOU

The power to heal is in you. Jesus is upholding all things by The WORD of His power. God is a healing God, and He's in you.

- I. The power to heal is in you.
 - What does it mean to plead the blood? The blood doesn't make faith work. Faith makes the blood work.
 - "So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by The WORD of God" (Romans 10:17).
 - When you say that scripture in faith, you have just thrown both covenants and all the exceedingly great and precious promises in the face of the devil the Name and the blood.
 - There was a war in heaven, and the serpent was cast out (Revelation 12:7-10).
 - "And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death" (Revelation 12:11).
 - God said, "Put me in remembrance: let us plead together: declare thou, that thou mayest be justified" (Isaiah 43:26).
 - My case is very simple, I plead the blood; I am no longer the guilty because of Jesus' blood.
- II. Jesus is upholding all things by The WORD of His power (Hebrews 1:3).
 - Words are the most powerful thing known to the human family. Man is the only mammal that can speak.
 - God's power was not activated in Creation until He spoke and created all things by The WORD of His power.
 - o He is still upholding all things by The WORD of His power.
 - o The universe is still expanding at the speed of light.
 - We live at the speed of faith. We are "living in the faith lane."





- III. God is a healing God, and He's in you.
 - Jesus said He came to do the will of the Father.
 - Jesus said, "The words that I speak unto you I speak not of myself: but the Father that dwelleth in me, he doeth the works" (John 14:10).
 - Jesus Himself, by the Spirit, lives on the inside of you. The power to heal is inside of you because *He's* on the inside of you. The Healer is in you.
 - Jesus preached, taught and healed everywhere He went (Matthew 9:35).
 - Then, Jesus sent the 12 disciples and commanded them to go and preach, teach and heal (see Matthew 10:1).
 - There is a reward for those who serve The LORD.
 - "And Jesus answered and said, Verily I say unto you, There is no man that hath left house, or brethren, or sisters, or father, or mother, or wife, or children, or lands, for my sake, and the gospel's, but he shall receive an hundredfold now in this time, houses, and brethren, and sisters, and mothers, and children, and lands, with persecutions; and in the world to come eternal life" (Mark 10:29-30).
 - "A new commandment I give unto you, That ye love one another; as I have loved you, that ye also love one another" (John 13:34).
 - o Loving one another is a commandment, not a heavenly suggestion.
 - Hold onto this promise: "THE BLESSING of The LORD, it maketh rich, and he addeth no sorrow with it" (Proverbs 10:22).

MAKE IT PERSONAL

DAY 2 – JESUS SET HIS CHURCH AGAINST SICKNESS AND DISEASE

Jesus went to the cities and villages, teaching, preaching and healing. T.L. and Daisy Osborn went to India, preaching faith in God. Jesus set His Church against sickness and disease.

- I. Jesus went to the cities and villages, teaching, preaching and healing.
 - He is the same yesterday, today and forever (Hebrews 13:8).
 - This is a working definition of faith: "Now faith is the assurance (the confirmation, the title deed) of the things [we] hope for, being the proof of things [we] do not see and the conviction of their reality [faith perceiving as real fact what is not revealed to the senses] (Hebrews 11:1, AMPC).
 - Faith is a spiritual force. What we see was not made out of nothing. It was made out of something you can't see—faith—this invisible, powerful, wonderful force of God, who is Love.
 - Have faith in God or have the faith of God (Mark 11:22). The moment we were born again, it was by faith.
- II. Brother T. L. and Daisy Osborn went to India, preaching faith in God.
 - The people of India asked Brother Osborn, "What is the difference between your God and ours?" He didn't know how to answer. He came home defeated.
 - The LORD took him to Mark 16:13-20 where Jesus appeared to the 11 disciples and rebuked them for their unbelief (Mark 16:14).
 - Then, Jesus gave them an assignment.
 - "Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature.... And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; they shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.... And they went forth, and preached every where, The LORD working with them, and confirming the word with signs following. Amen" (Mark 16:15-20).





- From that verse, Brother Osborn said he got his calling to preach healing, and that's what he did everywhere he went.
 - The next time Brother Osborn and Daisy went to India, blind people were healed. The people had the evidence that his God *is* the one true God.
- III. Jesus set His Church against sickness and disease.
 - Jesus ordained the disciples and gave them power against unclean spirits and power to heal all manner of sickness, disease and weakness.
 - On earth, Jesus was God manifested in the flesh.
 - He said, "I only say what I hear my Father say, I only do what I see my Father do" (see John 14:10, 5:30).
 - In Nazareth, He could do no mighty works (not that He would not) because of their unbelief (see Mark 6:5).
 - There is no such thing as nonbelief. Every human being is believing something.
 - Be cautious about what you are believing when you go to sleep. Don't go to sleep with fear. Read scriptures about the peace of God before you go to sleep.
 - Healing has not passed away.
 - o God said, "I am The LORD that healeth thee" (Exodus 15:26). Healing is His Name—*Jehovah Rapha*.
 - God said to Abraham, "I have *made* thee a father of many nations" (Romans 4:17). Abraham's faith in God's WORD *made* him righteous.
 - We have been *made* the righteousness of God in Him [Christ] (see 2 Corinthians 5:21).

MAKE IT PERSONAL

It's time to change our thinking. Sickness and disease are not situations we have to "just put up with." Sickness is from the enemy. Anything from a cold to diabetes, to heart problems, to cancer, are not God's will. Anything that makes us "not whole" is from the enemy and is meant for our destruction.

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DAY 3 – GOD'S DIVINE HEALING AND LONGEVITY PLAN

With divine healing, there is also divine longevity—living a long time. The suffering of Jesus on the cross and in the belly of the earth was greater than anyone had ever endured, and He did it for us! God is "The LORD of Hosts." Faith comes when you put your eyes on the Scriptures and believe what you read.

- I. With divine healing, there is also divine longevity—living a long time.
 - Moses interceded for the children of Israel because they were dying at 70 or 80. (Psalm 90:10).
 - The lifespan of 70 or 80 years was not intended to refer to anyone except those Israelites who were under the curse during the particular 40 years they were in the wilderness.
 - God said man's lifespan was limited to 120 years, not 70 or 80 (Genesis 6:3).
 - In the book of Leviticus, God gave dietary rules showing a sensible way to eat.
 - Obedience to God and eating sensibly allow you to follow His healing and longevity plan. He planned for you to live 120 years.
- II. The suffering of Jesus on the cross and in the belly of the earth was greater than anyone had ever endured, and He did it for us!
 - Isaiah 52-54 all have to do with the crucifixion of Jesus.
 - Surely He has borne our griefs (*AMPC*—sicknesses, weaknesses and distresses) and carried our sorrows (*AMPC*—pains) (Isaiah 53:4).
 - Isaiah prophesied what Jesus would go through on the cross (Isaiah 53).
 - The Psalms were written about Jesus.
 - o Jesus shouted, "Why hast thou forsaken me?" (Psalm 22:1).
 - Jesus died physically and spiritually. Spiritual death is separation from God.
 - Redemption wasn't finished at Jesus' death. He suffered in the heart of the earth for three days and three nights. Then, it was finished.
- III. One of God's Names is "The LORD of Hosts," Jehovah Sabbaoth.
 - That means The LORD of the angelic armies of God.





- The LORD of Armies is used in Malachi 24 times, as God reminds us He has armies of angels to carry out His will.
 - One of the things the angels are involved in is the return on your tithe (Malachi 3:11).
- Another thing they do is make sure you are fed and well.
 - "And ye shall serve the Lord your God, and he [your angel] shall bless thy bread, and thy water; and I will take sickness away from the midst of thee" (Exodus 23:25).
- IV. Faith comes when you put your eyes on the Scriptures and believe what you read.
 - God said, "Attend to my words," meaning, make them final authority (Proverbs 4:20-22).
 - "With everlasting kindness (chesed) will I have mercy on thee, saith The LORD thy Redeemer" (Isaiah 54:8).
 - *Chesed* is a Hebrew word, a covenant word. It means *the lesser is BLESSED by the greater*.
 - We must become so covenant-minded that we begin to receive and realize that our covenant is with the Almighty God.

MAKE IT PERSONAL

It's a comfort to know God's will. He wants you well and BLESSED. He wants you to enjoy a long life that follows His divine plan. All of this is yours; but you have to take it by believing in your heart and speaking in agreement with God's will.

Make this declaration:

I believe in my heart that God wants me healed and whole. He wants me to live a long life. Therefore, I make the decision to speak God's will in faith. I will not look nor believe, nor speak what I see around me or feel in my body. I only speak what God's WORD says. By Jesus' stripes, I was [past tense] healed (1 Peter 2:24).

I am glad and rejoice now, as if it's already here because faith behaves as if it's already done! I thank my God for His will in my life, in Jesus' Name.

DAY 4 – JESUS HEALED THEM ALL

Jesus was well known for His healing and miracle ministry. Jesus was manifested in the flesh when He was born in Bethlehem and was made alive in the Spirit when He was in hell. It was God who anointed the Man, Jesus. Jesus wants us to see the gospel of the kingdom with our eyes, hear with our ears, and understand in our hearts, so we can be healed.

- I. Jesus was well known for His healing and miracle ministry.
 - Jesus went about the cities and villages teaching, preaching and healing (Matthew 9:35).
 - The centurion who built the synagogue in Capernaum asked Jesus to say the word and his servant would be healed (Matthew 8:8).
 - o He was the centurion at the Cross (Matthew 27:54). His name was Cornelius.
 - Peter preached to Cornelius "how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him" (Acts 10:38).
- II. Jesus was manifested in the flesh when He was born in Bethlehem and was made alive in the Spirit when He was in hell.
 - Think about what happened between the Cross and the throne.
 - Jesus preached the gospel in the pit of hell. All who were in Paradise, the upper region of Sheol, were watching.
 - Remember the rich man who died and saw Father Abraham in Paradise (Luke 16:23).
 - o Right there in the pit of the hell, Jesus took the devil's keys away from him.
 - You have the authority now that Jesus has been raised from the dead.
 - Any tongue that rises up against you, you condemn. No weapon formed against you will prosper (Isaiah 54:17).
 - God turned everything over to the Son, who went to hell so we don't have to (Hebrews 1:2-3).





- III. It was God who anointed the Man, Jesus.
 - The second member of the Godhead is a human Man.
 - There had never been one like Him before, but there are a whole bunch like Him now.
 - o Had the devil known, he would never have crucified The LORD of glory.
 - Jesus got out of hell by the power of The WORD of the living God.
 - Jesus is no longer the only begotten Son of God. He is the firstborn from the dead.
 - We are born of Him. We have firstborn status.
 - o "If ye be Christ's, then are ye Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise" (Galatians 3:29).
- IV. Jesus wants us to see the gospel of the kingdom with our eyes, hear with our ears, and understand in our hearts, so we can be healed (Matthew 13:15).
 - You are going to have to make the decision: "God's WORD has changed my heart, and it has changed the way I think. Healing belongs to me."
 - Jesus is always ready to heal. The Church should be taking the message of healing to the world.
 - Jesus is the gift to the world. The Holy Spirit is the gift to the Church.

MAKE IT PERSONAL

Jesus healed when He walked the earth. Now it's our turn to receive healing and administer God's healing power to everyone we meet.

DAY 5 – HEALING COMES BY TEACHING AND PREACHING THE WORD

God and His WORD are one. Sickness is part of the curse, and we have been redeemed from the curse of the law. The prayer of agreement is another area of healing. Jesus came to do God's will—to teach, preach and heal.

- I. God and His WORD are one.
 - God's WORD is His covenant promises—blood-backed, blood-bought promises.
 - This was Jesus' ministry: He went about all the cities and villages teaching, preaching and healing (Matthew 9:35).
 - There are three different kinds of baptisms:
 - 1. Baptism in water. It won't save you but, in Brother Copeland's opinion, it is necessary.
 - 2. Baptism in the Holy Spirit.
 - 3. Baptism into the Body of Christ. The moment you accepted Jesus, you were immersed into the Body.
- II. Sickness is part of the curse, and we have been redeemed from the curse of the law (Galatians 3:13-14).
 - The curse of the law is found in Deuteronomy 27 and 28.
 - At the same time that Jesus bore our sins, He redeemed us from the curse of the law, in order that THE BLESSING of Abraham might come on the gentiles.
 - We are grafted-in Jews, because we of are the seed of Abraham (Romans 11:17; Galatians 3:29).
 - Everyone Jesus called and ordained to preach, He gave power and authority in His Name to heal the sick and cast out devils (Luke 10:9, 19).
 - o They laid hands on the sick in His Name (Mark 16:18).
 - Signs should be following the believer (Mark 16:20). It is the responsibility of the born-again believer.
 - This is *not* faith healing. We know the Healer, and His Spirit is alive and well on the inside of us, so we are alive and well.
 - o Take The LORD at His WORD.





- III. The prayer of agreement is another area of healing.
 - This is not the prayer of hoping.
 - To come to a place of agreement with God, you meditate the Scriptures and get an understanding of the articles of the agreement.
 - O Jesus said, "Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven. Again I say unto you, That if two of you shall agree on earth as touching any thing that they shall ask, it shall be done for them of my Father which is in heaven. For where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them" [to carry out the agreement] (Matthew 18:18-20).
 - You are to heal the sick, raise the dead, cast out devils, for freely you have received, freely give (Matthew 10:7-8).
- IV. Jesus came to do God's will—to teach, preach and heal (John 6:38).
 - Jesus has never changed. Healing is in the plan of Redemption. It was bought and paid for at the Cross, and in the pit of hell.
 - Healing always comes. It's like salvation. Salvation is always available.
 - The Greek word *sozo* is translated *saved* in some places, and in other places *healing*, indicating soundness and wholeness.
 - The plan of God is that you be whole—spirit, soul, body, financially, socially and in every way, sound and made well.
 - Healing comes by teaching and preaching.

MAKE IT PERSONAL
